



An inherently dry room, our custom saunas are created to meet the individual needs of each and every one of our clients.


We build stand-out saunas in homes and design premium saunas for commercial spas.

Traditional, bio or infra-red?

Our traditional saunas, have a dry heat and high temperatures, ranging from 70-110 degrees C. This is the 'Finnish' sauna experience most people have come to expect, which allows you to add water to the rocks to create traditional Finnish sauna 'löyly'.

Our bio/ humid saunas, in addition to being traditional, have the ability to run at lower temperatures, around 45-65 degrees C, but with a higher humidity level. These are ideal for those who want to spend more time relaxing in their sauna, with a lower, more comfortable temperature.







Nordic also offer infra-red technology, which is becoming increasingly popular. Ideal for smaller spaces and for those particularly interested in the health benefits of the infra-red spectrum.

The light emitted is absorbed by the skin, heating you up before the air around you. Infrared sources can also be incorporated into traditional saunas for a combined solution.

Sauna Timbers

Our FSC approved timbers are slowly grown in the forest of Northern Europe and harvested sustainably.

We have a wide selection of timbers and profiles to choose from when designing your sauna including, Alder, Aspen, Poplar, Magnolia, Cedar as well as thermally treated options.

Together with the traditional timber options, we have a great range of feature wall finishes including stone surfaces, coloured sauna board and tiles.



Salt walls


STEAM

Nordic designs a range of spa rooms, from traditional Hammams to contemporary steam rooms.


Unlike a sauna, a steam room is a wet environment with a lower ambient temperature.



There are a number of options for your steam room seating; from tiled & marble loungers, floating benches, back rests, soft seating, heated or unheated, bull-nose edged or square edged.

A kneipp hose or ice chute is a great addition to wash or cool down after your steam experience.







The temperature inside a steam room is generally between 42°c and 50°c with a humidity level of 100 percent. There are lots of design elements and features to think about when designing the space.

Might music appeal to you whilst you are unwinding in steam?

We think about it all; from the lighting experience, to the inspiration behind your tiling choices, to the aroma you bathe in and how best to operate the room based on your requirements.

Heated seating and floors are another way to increase the luxurious nature of a steam room.

After that sweat session, cool down with a cold water dip or shower to boost your body's circulation. Allow your body temperature to slowly cool down and hydrate yourself well.









You can expect to be personally involved in every step of the process as we explore possibilities, design, build and install your bespoke room.

Low Bench

Initial meeting

We always meet you and visit your property. This is our opportunity to explore with you the art of the possible in terms of design ideas and to understand fully the dimensions and nature of your space.

We discuss material options such as timber or tiling choices, and to focus on areas such as lighting and sound. This is very much a two-way process and we are always keen to understand your own individual preferences and style choices which we translate into our final designs.

Stage one design

Further to meeting with you, we will use the findings of our visit to task our team of talented designers with producing a stage one design. This will be produced using the latest in CAD techniques and will provide an overview of what your sauna or steam room could look like, including dimensions and features such as seating and heater location. There is also the option of having a 3D render produced to give a comprehensive idea of what your project will look like. A quotation will be provided at this stage considering previously discussed choices and style preferences.

Final design stage

If appointed to undertake your project, the designer who produced initial drawings for your project will be assigned formally to develop the concept into a final design. This is a thoroughly two-way conversation, and it is at this stage that final decisions on the finer details of your sauna or steam room will be made.

Construction, installation and after-care

With a set of approved drawings, our teams will get to work on procuring what's needed for your project and begin the construction phase. We have our own team of carpenters and fitters who all have a part to play in the construction and installation of your project.

You will be appointed with a lead fitter who will talk you through each step of the installation as they arrive on site.

Our General Manager will keep you updated throughout the process and is your single point of communication following the approval of our designs – right up to completion and commissioning.
